PARKING – 4771 Campus Drive Irvine 92612

Bus and Truck Parking is located in the **Main School Entrance** (turn into the lot off Culver Avenue at Chuck Keith Way). Buses and equipment vehicles will be directed to their designated staging area via signs and by parking lot personnel.

Spectator Parking is available in the side and back lot (off of Campus Drive). There is no charge for parking on site. Overflow parking will be directed to the field. Please drive slowly and be considerate that there are many students on campus.

ARRIVAL PROCEDURES

Upon arrival, please proceed to the check-in desk located directly in front of the **large painted Trojans sign** on the **Gym** (faces Culver Ave.). At check-in, you will be given a Director's Packet and we will provide wristbands for students, essential parent volunteers, and staff lanyards. Please check your packet upon arrival to see if any changes or updates have been made to the performance schedule. *One chaperone wristband will be given to each band for every 10 students performing.* If you need more wristbands, you can purchase them at the ticket office. Everyone must have a wristband to enter the stadium.

CHANGING AREAS / RESTROOMS

Restrooms are located within the campus for performers and are near the warm-up areas. **Uniform changing must be done in your buses. Please do not allow your students to use the restroom areas for changing in or out of their uniforms.**

WARM-UP AREAS

There are four (4) warm-up zones and four (4) adjunct warm-up zones. Your designated warm-up and adjunct warm-up zones will be clearly marked and student guides will assist you in locating those areas. Color Guard Warm-Up is located at the Tennis Courts. Please reference the Logistical Schedule to note the start of your warm-up time. Although you do not need to be at the Staging Gate a full 10 minutes prior to your performance, it is strongly encouraged. Any ensemble responsible for delaying the tournament will receive the maximum timing penalty assessed to your final score. As always, keep an eye on your watch. Bands are instructed to face away from the stadium during warm-up to ensure there is no noise interference. Please be considerate of other performing bands and prompt in exiting when your warm-up time has expired. **Please do NOT warm-up in the BUS/TRUCK parking lot.** This is a safety hazard and we want to ensure everyone's safety while at the tournament.

FOOD

Food preparation/cooking is NOT ALLOWED on the UHS Campus. Please do not set up tables or easy-ups in the parking lot or along the path to the Stadium. There are grassy areas, lunch tables, and seating areas located near the Quiet Zone. We also offer multiple food vendors and concessions with a variety of food, drinks, and snacks. ***The sale of food and beverages is the single largest source of income for our entire event.*** Please support a fellow instrumental music program. Your patronage is appreciated!

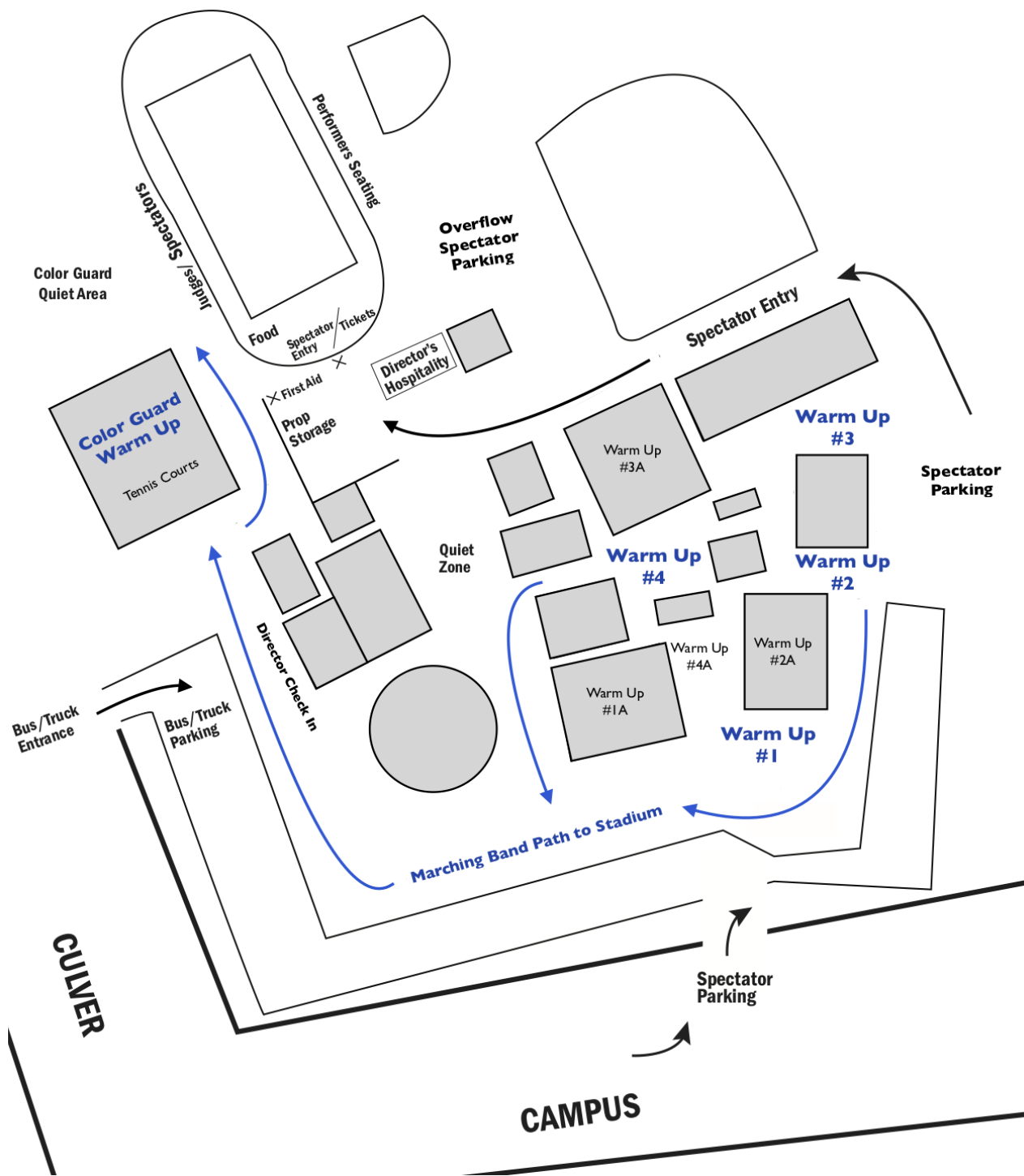

How To Enter/Exit the Field

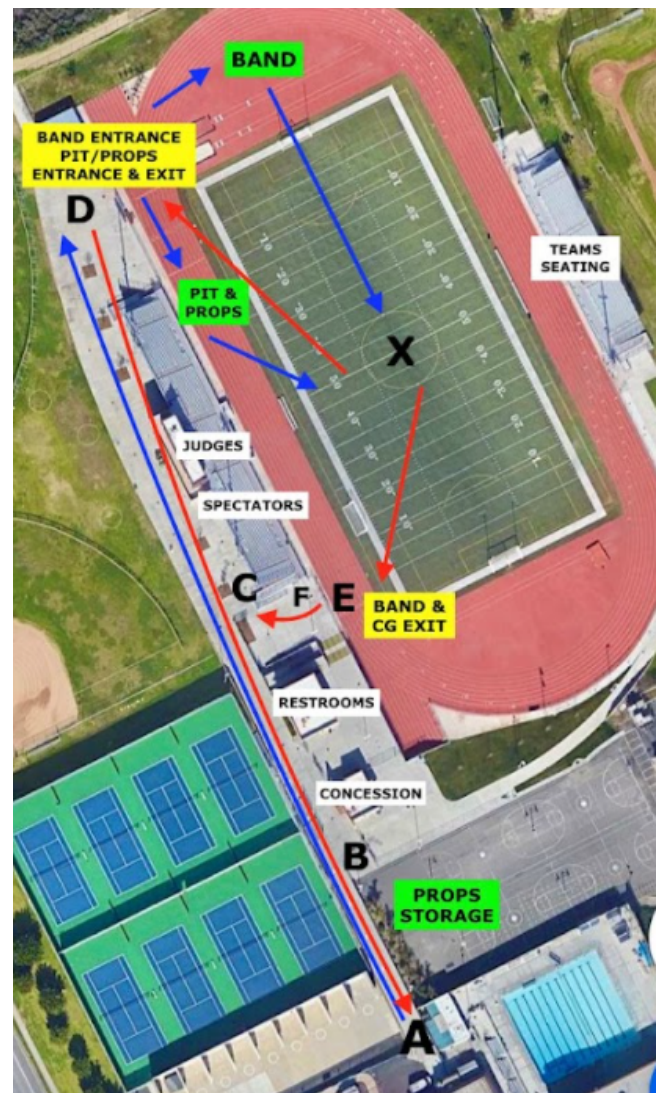
Props may be left at the Prop Storage area and pick them up as you head to the stadium for your performance.

10 minutes prior to your performance time, move to holding point **A** and await further instructions.

When you are cleared to move, proceed to point **D** on the map. Please keep to the left as you may pass another ensemble exiting the field.

As the previous ensemble finishes their performance, you will be asked to move into place along the fence for the pit and outside the end zone for band and color guard. You may take the field when directed by the announcer.

After your performance has finished, pit and props will exit via the same gate they entered on Side 1. Beware of an oncoming ensemble and please keep to the left side of the path. Band and color guard will exit Side 2 via the gate at the opposite end of the stadium that they entered (labeled point **E** on the map). Depart the stadium on the left side of the path and proceed to Bus/Truck Parking via ramp. Props may be placed back in Prop Storage or moved immediately to the parking area.



THE HOSPITALITY ROOM (staff badges only)

The Director's Hospitality Area will be located near the spectator entrance adjacent to the field.

FIRST AID

For minor first aid needs, there is a first aid station near the spectator entrance to the stadium.

ELECTRICAL POWER

Electrical power is available at the field level on the front of the field near the 50 yard line. If we blow a fuse, it is the competitor's responsibility to have a back-up source of electrical power.

PERFORMER RE-ENTRY AND SEATING

Performers may re-enter the stadium after their performance and sit in the visitor's stands. We will not designate specific areas, but please ask your students to sit together.

PERUSAL PERIOD

All recap and tapes will be distributed via Competition Suite. The association has requested that directors listen to tapes before distributing recaps and speaking to judges if possible. This will allow time for more informed feedback and conversation before the awards ceremony. You may then approach the head judge to speak with an adjudicator as inclined.

RAIN

In the event of rain, we will move the competition into our large Gym. Bands will be judged regardless of weather. Staging will be in the Main Gym. We will judge captions as space allows. No refunds will be given.

Staff Viewing Area/Video Taping Area

This area will be located at the top of the stands and to the left or right of the press box.

Post-Contest Critique Location

This area will be located next to the stadium where ensembles exit.
