BUS AND TRUCK DIRECTIONS TO SAN G:

From the 10 West:

If you are coming from the 10 West, take the 210 West once you make it to Redlands. Exit off of Highland Ave., turn left onto Highland Ave., and then take a left onto Arden. Arden is a light that comes up 50 feet after you turn off the freeway. Continue down Arden until you reach Pacific, and turn right on Pacific Ave. You will see the school on your left and will be parking in the West lot. There will be signs visible, and there will be someone to greet you when you arrive.

From the 91/215 North or 15 South:

From the 91 to 215 or the 15 South, you will want to take 210 East. Exit Highland Ave., and take a left onto Highland Ave. You will take a right onto Arden at the next light. Continue down Arden until you reach Pacific, and turn right on Pacific Ave. You will see the school on your left and will be parking in the West lot. There will be signs visible, and there will be someone to greet you when you arrive.

SPECTATOR PARKING:

All spectators, whether carrying a student or not, will park in the **East** lot on Arden Ave.

BAND CHECK-IN:

Upon your arrival, a band check-in volunteer will greet you. At this time you will be led to your parking spaces, receive your director's packet, and meet your band guide.

WRISTBANDS FOR STUDENTS:

In your packet, you will be given wristbands for each performing student, which will allow them access in and out of the stadium.

WRISTBANDS FOR DIRECTORS/STAFF/CHAPERONES:

Unlike previous years there will be no wristbands issued for staff. The badges issued by CSBC will grant directors and staff into the stadium and hospitality. Please do not give your badges to anyone other than staff members. There will be wristbands for parent helpers/pit crew that will permit them onto the track to help with equipment, and into the stadium to watch bands perform. You will be issued 1 wristband for every 10 performing students

BAND GUIDES:

We will be providing one band guide for each band that will lead you to warm-up areas, staging, and back to your buses at the end of your performance. Many of you have come to our tournament for years and may not require a band guide. Our campus is small and easy to navigate. If that is the case, please let your band guide know that they are not required, and we will switch them to another group.

PERFORMANCE ENTRANCE/EXIT:

Getting to the entrance of our stadium is not ideal since the stadium is lower than the rest of the campus. Unfortunately, there is not a paved direct path from our side of campus to the stadium. To avoid going down a steep grass hill, bands will be led down a paved path to a practice field that is to the right of the stadium. You will be led through this grass to our stadium.

If you have equipment/props/etc. that cannot be pushed through grass, it will be led in the opposite direction around campus to the stadium. This route is longer and will require more time to get to the stadium so please be sure to let me or your band guide know that you have equipment that will need this alternate route.

You will exit the stadium as you came in and be led on the same route back to the parking lot where your buses are. Again, if you have equipment/props/etc. that will need the alternate route, they will go back the same way.

POWER AT THE 50:

We will have an extension cord powered at the 50-yard line for your use.

POST-PERFORMANCE SEATING:

Your students are welcome to find any open bleachers to sit on either the home side or the away side.

AWARDS:

There will be two award ceremonies: 1A/2A/3A at 3:30 pm, and 4A/5A at 8:00 p.m. The California State Band Champions Association will be handling trophies and what awards are given.

HOSPITALITY:

There will still be delicious food but there will be a combination of ready-made offerings along with hot offerings to accommodate each guest. This area is for directors/staff; only persons wearing a CSBC Staff Badge will be allowed in.

SNACK BAR & VENDORS:

The San G. Band Boosters will be offering a mostly pre-packaged snack bar. **We will be accepting Cash or Venmo.**
