



## 2026 Percussion/Winds March 28th Competition

### Welcome

On behalf of the Schurr High School Band and Color Guard program, I would like to extend a warm welcome and personal thank you for participating in our CSBC Percussion/Winds Competition. We plan to serve you in the best capacity possible!

### Arrival/Check-In

**PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE EARLIER THAN 2 hours before your performance, per CSBC rules.**

The Competition will take place entirely in the upper campus of the school.

Busses will park in the upper parking lot adjacent to the tennis courts entering off of Wilcox Ave (please see enclosed map). Do NOT enter off of Vail Ave. That will be a designated EXIT.

Directors will receive a packet upon check-in with wristbands for student performers, as well as wristbands for chaperones/staff. These wristbands will only give access to the visitor side stands. Performing groups are welcome to watch other ensembles on the visitor side.

**If chaperones wish to sit on the home side before/after their ensemble, they will need to purchase a regular show ticket. (\$12) We will provide you with the specified staff/volunteer wristband amounts below. If you wish to purchase more volunteer or staff wristbands, you may also purchase them at the box office for \$12.**

**Those without wristbands will not be allowed into the gym.**

**Volunteer wristbands: 1 wristband per 10 performers**

**Staff wristbands: 1 wristband per 10 performers, plus extra director wristband**

*Staff members will also need wristbands to enter hospitality.*

## **Announcements**

There is a standard announcer for the event. **We will also be placing a blank announcement script in your packet that you will need to accurately and legibly fill out and turn in at the check-in table upon your arrival.** This is the script that will be used at all of the future competitions you participate in.

## **Warm-Up**

Full ensemble warm-up/percussion warm-ups will take place in the stadium. Each warm-up area will be labeled (also on the map) so please go to your designated assigned warm up zone per the CSBC logistical schedule. Please do not play or warm-up anywhere that is not designated by a letter. Failure to do so will constitute a penalty (found in the CSBC Contest Rules) after the first warning. **Please do not switch warm-up spots other than your assigned area as it will interfere with show logistics or other activities on campus.**

## **Ensemble Entry/Exit Point**

All performing groups will enter at the northwest gymnasium doors (on the visitor side/back side 2). Ensembles will line up outside gym between the swimming pool and the gym. The gym doors of BACK SIDE 2. One (1) double door will be available for entry.

Ensembles will exit the back side 2 doors, out and to the left onto the blacktop. Right outside gym doors there is place for drums to set their equipment down out of the way of the remainder of the exiting group. It is the ensembles' responsibility to remove all equipment from the gymnasium after their performance.

Be sure to have your group positioned to enter the gym ONE full performance slot ahead of your own. Late or early arrival to the gym will cause a traffic jam in staging and may cause a timing penalty of your own group to enter the gym. Please plan accordingly.

## **Percussion Equipment/Props**

Please make sure you have adequate staff and means to assist the moving of your percussion equipment and props to and from the performance area.

*Any damage caused to the gymnasium or other parts of campus is the responsibility of the performing ensemble. Please ensure your props and equipment are "accident proof" and do not drag or push anything across the floors of any part of our campus.*

## **Seating in Stands**

Upon completion of your band's performance, please have your group sit on the visitor side to watch shows. Students will have full access to concessions and vendors. You can let your students know concessions will accept both cash and card.

LOCAL RULE CONCERNING FOOD SERVICE/BARBECUES: ABSOLUTELY NO FOOD SERVICES OR BARBECUES WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE PARKING LOT. THERE ARE NO OUTSIDE FOOD/DRINK OR COOLERS ALLOWED INTO THE CAMPUS, STADIUM, GYMNASIUM OR PARKING LOTS.

Performing units are allowed to bring water for their performances.

### **Admission/Concession Stand**

Admission to this regular season event is \$12, with kids 5 and under being free. A variety of food and beverages will be on sale to your students, chaperones, and band parents. This is a fundraiser event and we encourage all participants to support the Schurr High School Band and Color Guard and Drill Team by purchasing food at the concession stands outside the gym.

### **Hospitality**

To show our gratitude for your participation in our event, we have a hospitality area prepared for all directors and staff in the **Small Gym**. You can find this area across from the tennis courts.

*Staff and directors must have a staff wristband to enter.*

Please do not send parents/chaperones to this area. Our hospitality room is sponsored by the Schurr High School Band Boosters. We do have a small token of our gratitude for each director/program caption. Enjoy!

### **Awards Ceremony**

The awards ceremony will begin after the last performing group (approximately 30 minutes).

Please have approximately 2 - 4 student leaders outside the performer re-entry doors (back side 1) immediately after the last performance.

### **Spectator Parking**

Spectator parking is available in the upper parking lot adjacent to the tennis courts closest to the gyms. Please make sure you are paying attention to any street parking signs.
